New Horizon Gift Basket: won by Karen Wilhelms

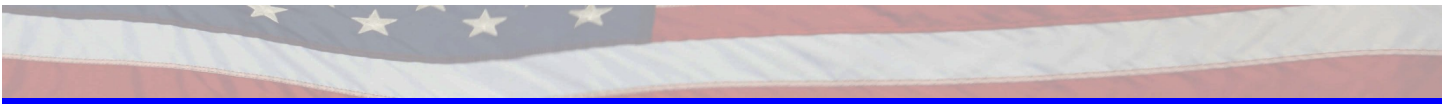

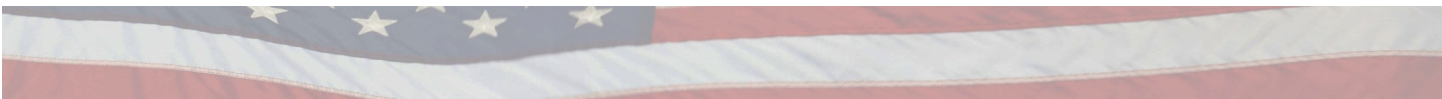
