October 1, 2024

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by President Carol Pruett at 12:02 pm.

Members and guests were asked to silence their phones. Chaplain Bea Evans gave the invocation and a reminder to love our neighbors. Millie Morris led the Pledge of Allegiance. Dignitaries, guests, & candidates were introduced.

Recording Secretary: Minutes were printed in the newsletter. Hearing no additions or corrections, minutes were accepted as printed to be filed.

Treasurer's Report: Financial Statement is available on the back of the agenda. No corrections were heard, report approved and will be filed for review.

Americanism: Presented by Sue Fritch. Shared Henry Ford's Model T and his desire to produce a less expensive vehicle revolutionized the conveyor belt system for the auto industry.

Announcements:

Special Presentation: Award presented to Bea Evans.

AzFRW Conference - Tucson, October 17-19. Three attending.

NFRW Western Conference – Westlake Village, CA. January 9-11 – Includes Ronald Reagan Presidential Library and Museum.

Dodie Londen: Kimberly Zanon was nominated and awarded this prestigious honor. She spoke about her beginning with the foster care system and her strong belief that it is a candidate's choice how they run their election campaigns. Whether you win or lose, how you treat others is a choice.

Business:

Legislative: Is not currently in session. Joan Dzuro spoke about the SAVE Act.

Volunteer Hours: Members reminded to document and submit all non-profit volunteer hours.

Nomination Slate: Gaynell Crews presented the 2025 Slate & informed members of the procedure should they want to run from the floor. The election will be held in November with the Installation taking place in December.

Parades - London Bridge Day - October 26 & Veteran's Day – November 11. The club has a float. David Diaz has tons of flags. The mayor is taking care of the logistics.

Basket items needed: Kay & Sonnie were thanked for the beautiful baskets. Members were reminded that donations of good quality items or gift cards are needed.

Program:

LHC Mayor Cal Sheehy: The Mayor provided an impressive update on what is going on in the city. He thanked the club for being good to all candidates. He reminded members there are **5 candidates** running for the LHC School Board. **David Diaz** will be seated at the 2nd Council Meeting. The mayor is pushing back against **ASU's** decision to close the LHC Campus. ASU still has an unexpired lease agreement. The mayor is reviewing that lease. Reiterates, ASU has money – the closure is agenda driven. **MCC** will now offer a Bachelor program, and they will have a pathway to become teachers. He discussed the Unisource rates. The **AZCC** controls the electric rates whereas LHC controls the water rates. Thanked Buster Johnson for getting the AZCC to come to LHC. He recognizes that people are struggling to determine which bill to pay. He is attempting to get AZCC to reconsider the rates. Spoke about how just 2 citizens acquired 12,000 signatures regarding the electric rates. **Fire station 7** will move forward at the Sloop & McCulloch location. The **2nd bridge** is an emergency evacuation bridge. Will undergo a name change once funding requirements are met.

The **downtown park** is being renovated. Park naming will be done based on citizen input. 92% of park funding is from the awarding of a community grant. Treated **wastewater** will be released back into the lake water. Also pending are grants to bring affluent water to several LHC parks. **Kiowa Ponds** is in front of the Planning and Zoning Committee. Anderson Auto has purchased the property with intent to consolidate their facilities. October 4th was the most recent **Coffee** with the Mayor. **LHHS Golden Shovel** game – wear purple to show your support. **Migrant issue** – “There is no issue – there is no housing – It’s just not a thing”. Stop light - Southside HWY 95 **Sarah Park** speedway entrance – funding issue. **David Diaz** speaks to appropriate news sources – don’t get your news from FB, ND, O&O.

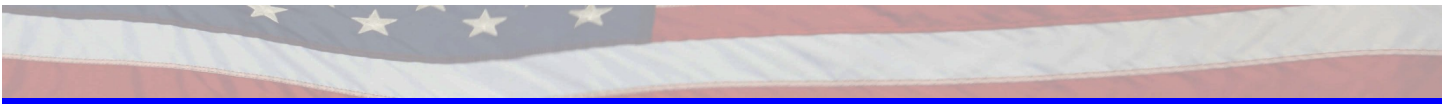

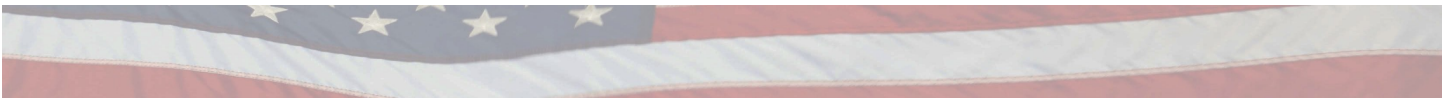

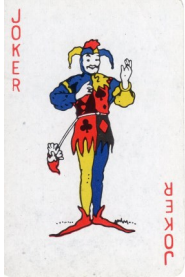

You continue to support Military Moms every month all year. Cindy will be our guest speaker to bring you up to date and explain what Military Moms do in our community,

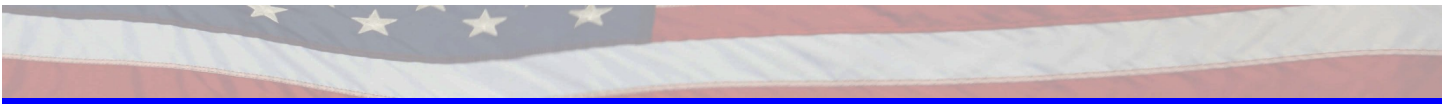
